## HIGH DESERT SAVES WATER HE Clothes Washer Rebate Application



### TO QUALIFY

1. Purchase and install a new High Efficiency Clothes Washer with a water factor (WF) rating of 6.0 or less as determined by the Consortium for Energy Efficiency (CEE).
2. Applicant must have a current water account and receive water directly from a participating water district within MWA's service area.
3. Applicant must provide a copy of their most recent bill when submitting their High Efficiency Clothes Washer application.
4. Applicants that do not receive a water bill directly from the water district, such as those residing in mobile home parks, townhouses or condominiums, must obtain a copy of their most recent water bill from their property manager or landlord.
5. There is a limit of 1 (one) clothes washer per household.
6. Each new High Efficient Clothes Washer must replace an existing high water use clothes washer.
7. Applicant agrees to pay any and all sales tax, installation parts, labor and building costs associated with the new High Efficiency Clothes washer installation.

### REBATE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Purchase and install a qualifying EnergySaver® rated High Efficiency Clothes Washer.
2. One rebate will be issued for one clothes washer.
3. Once the rebate application is approved, a rebate package is mailed to the customer.
4. Rebate packages include a list of EnergySaver® approved High Efficiency Clothes Washers replacements along with a list of participating vendors.
5. Applicant completes, signs and dates the other side of this application and returns it with a copy of current water bill and original dated sales receipt to address at bottom of the other side of this application.

### REBATE AMOUNT

The value of the High Efficiency Clothes Washer rebate is \$175. Any clothes washer cost that exceeds the rebate value is to be paid by the applicant and is the sole responsibility of the applicant. Additional funding may be provided through your local water district's participation and will be added to the rebate check. There is no refund for any unused rebate monies.

### VERIFICATION OF INSTALLATION

Your water district reserves the right to inspect to verify the installation of the new clothes washer model submitted for this rebate program, and if contacted, you agree to allow for a post-installation inspection.

### DURATION

The start date for the Clothes Washer Rebate Program is February 1, 2008. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis, only while funding is available, or until the program is discontinued. MWA/DWR, in its discretion, may, at any time modify, suspend, or terminate this program without prior notice.

**Disclaimers:** MWA reserves the right to reject any application that does not meet all of the requirements this rebate program. MWA makes no representations or warranties as to the condition, quality, effectiveness, operability or cost of installing or maintaining a high efficiency clothes washer subject to this program, or of removing or disposing of a low efficiency clothes washer, associated parts, building materials, labor and equipment in connection therewith and, to the extent not prohibited by law, disclaims all express and implied conditions, representations and warranties related thereto, including without limitation, any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.
