HIGH DESERT SAVES WATER High Efficiency Toilet Rebate Application



Mojave Water Agency (MWA), in partnership with your local water district and the State of California Department of Water Resources, are offering rebates valued at \$165 when qualified water users replace existing high water using toilets with EPA WaterSense® rated high efficiency toilet (HET) models. Additional funding may be provided by your local water district and will be added to your rebate value.

Typically pre-1985 toilets use between 5-7 gallons per flush (gpf) and post-1985 to pre-1991 use 3.5 gpf. A high efficiency toilet uses an average of 1.28 gallons or less per flush with a savings of more than 63% every time it is flushed. A family of 3 (three) can save more than 33 gallons of water per day with a new high efficiency toilet.

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TO QUALIFY

1. High efficiency toilets (HET)s must be installed in a single-family dwelling built before 1992.
2. Applicant must have a current water account and receive water directly from a participating water district within MWA's service area.
3. Applicant must provide a copy of their most recent bill when submitting their high efficiency toilet rebate application.
4. There is a limit of 2 (two) toilets per household.
5. Toilets can be one piece (tank and bowl as one unit) or two pieces (tank and bowl) to be fitted together for a complete unit.
6. Each new toilet must replace an existing high water use toilet using 3.5 gallons per flush (GPF) or more.
7. Instructions on how to calculate the flush volume of a current toilet are included with this application.
8. Applicant agrees to not reuse, sell, or give away the old toilet and must provide for proper disposal.
9. Applicant agrees to pay any and all sales tax, installation parts (ex. wax ring, bolts, flex hose, toilet seat), labor and building costs associated with the HET installation.

REBATE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Purchase and install a qualifying WaterSense® rated high efficiency toilet(s).
2. One rebate will be issued for one toilet.
3. Once the rebate application is approved, a rebate package is mailed to the customer.
4. Applicant completes, signs and dates the other side of the application and returns it with a copy of current water bill and original dated sales receipt to address at bottom of the other side of this application.

REBATE AMOUNT

The value of the high efficiency toilet voucher is \$165 and may cover the entire retail cost of an HET if the total cost does not exceed the total value of the rebate. High efficiency toilet purchase cost that exceeds the rebate value is not covered under this program. Any high efficiency toilet cost that exceeds the rebate value is to be paid by the applicant and is the sole responsibility of the applicant. Additional funding may be provided through your local water district's participation and will be added to the rebate check. There is no refund for any unused rebate monies.

VERIFICATION OF INSTALLATION

Your water district reserves the right to inspect to verify the installation of the new HET model submitted for this rebate program, and if contacted, you agree to allow for a post-installation inspection.

DURATION

The start date for the High Desert High Efficiency Toilet Rebate Program is February 1, 2008. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis, only while funding is available, or until the program is discontinued. MWA/DWR, in its discretion, may, at any time modify, suspend, or terminate this program without prior notice.

Disclaimers: MWA reserves the right to reject any application that does not meet all of the requirements this rebate program. MWA makes no representations or warranties as to the condition, quality, effectiveness, operability or cost of installing or maintaining a high efficiency toilet subject to this program, or of removing or disposing of a low efficiency toilet, associated parts, building materials, labor and equipment in connection therewith and, to the extent not prohibited by law, disclaims all express and implied conditions, representations and warranties related thereto, including without limitation, any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

Limitation of Liability/Release: Applicant understands and agrees that to, the extent not prohibited by law, in no event shall MWA, its officials, officers, employees or agents be liable for any claimed or actual damages or losses of any kind, however caused and regardless of the theory of liability, related in any way to this rebate incentive program, even if MWA has been advised of the possibility of such damages or losses. To the extent not prohibited by law, applicant assumes all risks associated with this program, including without limitation, all risks associated with purchase, installation and maintenance of an HET model subject to this program (including without limitation the risk of not realizing cost savings as a result of converting to a high efficiency toilet model), and the removal and disposal of old toilets, associated parts, building materials, labor and equipment in connection therewith. Applicant releases MWA its officials, officers, employees and agents from any and all claims for damage or death or injury to any persons or property arising in any way from this rebate program, including the installation of an HET, associated parts, building materials, labor and equipment subject to this program (including without limitation the use or operation thereof), or the removal or disposal of any toilet, associated parts, building materials, labor and equipment in connection therewith, other than those caused solely by the willful or grossly negligent acts or omission of MWA.
