Ames Reche Groundwater Storage & Recovery Project

The Ames Reche project is finally under construction. This is a regional facility being utilized by several local water agencies: BDVWA, HDWD, MWA and County Special Districts Zones W-1 Landers and W-4 Pioneertown. The project will recharge up to 1,500 acre-feet of State Water Project deliveries via the Morongo Basin Pipeline to meet the water needs of these entities well into the future.
