Why could this change be good for both customers of BDVWA and County Service Area 70/Zone W-1?

The properties served by County Special Districts reside in the same community as those served by BDVWA. Consolidation would add an additional 9 square miles to existing Agency territory of 43 square miles. We believe that, based simply on "economy of scale", reorganization with Zone W-1 will result in more efficient and effective service, at a lower overall cost, to all customers as time

goes on. Currently Zone W-1 is represented by the County Board of Supervisors who preside over all issues concerning the entire County of San Bernardino which reduces overall transparency and access to the elected body. In contrast, the
